Title: National Squads Support

Job summary:

The National Squads Support is responsible for assisting at National Squads training sessions and in-country competition as requested by the National Squads Head Coach and/or National Squads Committee Liaison and/or Team Manager(s). The role is to support the Assistant Coaches and Team Manager(s) in delivering the programme. Plans for the National Squad training weekends change throughout the days so flexibility is key.

Key tasks:

- Liaise with the National Squads Head Coach and/or National Squads Committee Liaison and support the National Squads training dates/matches as requested
- Ensure understanding of the Swiss team's objectives in all areas for the session as requested by the Head Coach and work together to achieve it
- Prepare and tape the courts prior to match play
- Support Assistant coaches with setting up equipment and officiating as and when required
- Assist with scoring and stat taking as and when required
- Keep abreast of rule updates
- Maintain professionalism and impartiality at all times
- Dress appropriately at all times
- Liaise with Officiating Lead on behalf of Team Manager(s) regarding umpires if required
- Support the National Squad in other duties as required

Qualifications

- Fluent in English and minimum working knowledge French would be an advantage
- Possess excellent communication and interpersonal skills with experience collaborating in a diverse and dynamic team
- Flexibility is essential
- Excellent knowledge of netball rules
- Qualified Europe Netball Umpire Award holder

- Approximate time required per month: Minimum 6-8 hours
- The position is for a two-year period.
