Job Title: National Squad Performance Analyst

Summary: The National Squad Head Coach is seeking a detail-oriented and analytical Performance Analyst (PA) to join the National Squad Management team. As the National Squad PA you will be responsible for using data and video analysis to enhance the performance of individual athletes and the squad. The role will require you to work closely with the coaches, athletes and other support staff to provide insights that inform training and competition strategies. The ideal candidate has strong analytical, problem-solving and communication skills.

Key tasks and responsibilities:

- Develop and implement performance measurement systems and performance metrics that align with Swiss Netball's strategic goals and objectives for the National Squad
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to develop performance improvement strategies and initiatives
- Gather, interpret and analyse performance data using various tools such as video analysis software and statistical software
- Maintain statistical and video databases and logs as requested
- Compile and present detailed reports on findings and performance outcomes
- Monitor and evaluate athletes progress and provide data-driven recommendations for improvement

Qualifications & Skills

- Strong knowledge of the sport and understanding of the Rules of Netball
- Possess excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills
- Proficiency in Excel and ideally data analysis software and video analysis tools
- Knowledge of sports performance evaluation metrics and indicators, ideally netball
- Excellent attention to detail
- Fluent in English and minimum working knowledge French/German would be an advantage
- Flexibility is essential

Reporting & Liaison

The Performance Analyst will work in close coordination primarily with the National Squad Head Coach and Coaching team. The Swiss Netball Committee however maintains overall direction for the National Squad. The Performance Analyst will also liaise with other key individuals where relevant.

Time Commitment

- May require travel to various training and competition venues
- Approximate time required per month: 8-10 hours. This is not spread equally across the year
- The position is for a one-year period.
