Job title: Clubs and Schools Lead

Summary: The Schools and Clubs Lead is responsible for developing grassroots netball in Switzerland via the establishment of new clubs and introduction of netball into schools.

Key tasks

- Develop and own a Schools and new Clubs programme
- Establish a 'new club' package to aid interested parties including funding options
- Establish an 'in school' package including funding equipment and supplies and training staff/coaches
- Coordinate netball vacation programs
- Join sport exhibition days to showcase netball via demonstrations
- Report key progress indicators to the Growth lead on a regular basis

Qualifications/ skills

- Fluent in English and a national language (French, German or Italian)
- Knowledge of netball either as a player, coach or umpire
- The ability to plan, prepare and implement a well-structured and progressive annual programme
- Excellent administration skills and people skills with experience collaborating in a diverse and dynamic team
- Able to apply reflective practice to seek continuous improvement
- Prior experience of working in a non-profit organisation is a plus
