## GUIDELINES

- Scorekeepers must sit together, score together, and verify after each goal.
- Goals are scored when the umpire shows the “goal” hand signal. Goals are disallowed when the umpires show the “no goal” hand signal.
- Scorekeepers advise the umpires that they agree with each other’s score and confirm the next centre pass with the umpires at the start of each interval. Scorekeepers confirm the centre pass again with the umpires just before the next quarter / half start.
- Both scorekeepers and both umpires must sign both score sheets at the end of the match.
- Score sheets must be handed in by the umpires after the match.
- All scoring must be done in accordance with the tournament rules.

A FEW THINGS TO MEMORISE
1. THE TEAM WHO HAS THE FIRST CENTRE PASS IS <b>EVEN (+)</b>
2. THE QUARTER / HALF ENDS ONE OF TWO WAYS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>AFTER A GOAL</b>; THE (+) AND THE (-) WILL <b>STAY</b></li> <li>• <b>DURING PLAY</b>; THE (+) AND THE (-) WILL <b>SWAP</b></li> </ul>
3. ADD THE SCORES OF THE TWO TEAMS TOGETHER <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IF THE <b>TOTAL OF THE TWO SCORES</b> IS AN <b>EVEN</b> NUMBER, THE TEAM WITH A <b>(+)</b> IS ENTITLED TO THE NEXT CENTRE PASS</li> <li>• IF THE <b>TOTAL OF THE TWO SCORES</b> IS AN <b>ODD</b> NUMBER, THE TEAM WITH A <b>(-)</b> IS ENTITLED TO THE NEXT CENTRE PASS</li> </ul>
